Students who successfully complete this CTE program are able to earn 4th year math credit, 3rd year science credit, 2nd year World Language Credit, and Visual Performing and Applied Arts credit. **In addition, students successfully completing the Construction Trades Program are eligible to earn Algebra 2 credit with prior approval from their local district.** It is also possible to earn articulated college credit through a partnership with **Delta College** for students who successfully complete the CTE program.
