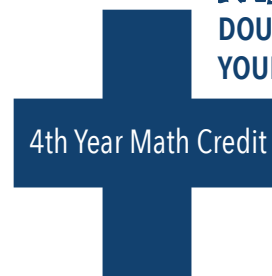
Health Occupations

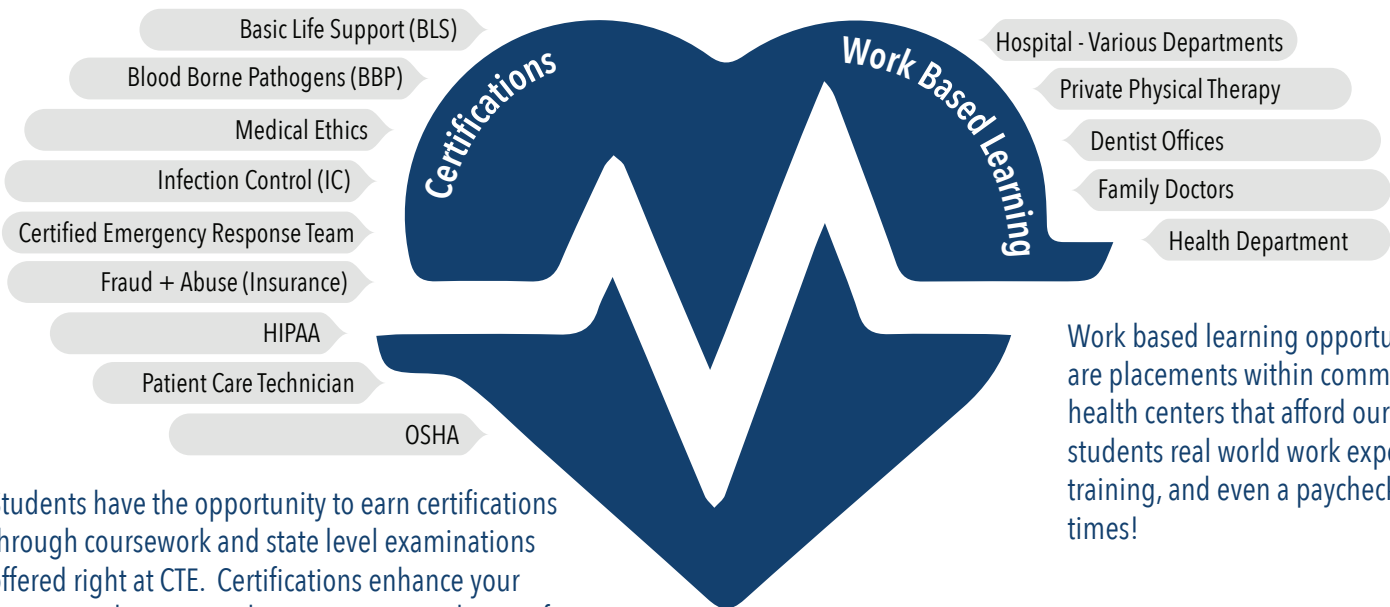
